



GIFT AID DECLARATION

Donor Privacy Notice

Data Protection is assured by the Trustees of The Canterbury Food Bank (CFB).

The CFB collects and handles your personal information in line with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Only staff and volunteers who have a reason to look at your information can do so. Each member of the CFB has signed a confidentiality agreement which commits them not to disclose your personal information outside the CFB.

The CFB will never sell personal information or share it with third parties unrelated to the services we provide unless required to do so by law or unless you have told us that you consent to our doing this.

Your personal information will be stored for 6 years in line with HMRC audit requirements, and then deleted. You cannot request it to be deleted before this time, but you may request it to be amended by contacting the CFB Data Protection Lead on dpl@canterburyfoodbank.co.uk

At any time you can lodge a complaint about how your personal data is being used by contacting the UK Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).
