About CFB Internship programme.

This internship will provide school leavers, undergraduates, graduates and people changing careers a taster of what it is like working for a large food bank. The opportunity is open to anyone looking to develop their skills and gain experience in the workplace. No previous experience of working in the charity sector is needed. Mostly, you need to be enthusiastic and committed to making the most of your time with us.

During the internship you will receive ongoing advice and support.

What will you cover

- Helping in the warehouse with sorting donated food and packing food parcels.
- Helping to oversee stock control.
- Learning skills to help oversee our volunteers.
- Helping staff and volunteers to collect donations.
- Assisting our signposting team who take calls from clients. Book the food parcels onto our systems and refer to supporting agencies where appropriate.
- Assisting with supermarket instore days.
- Assisting with parcel pick up points in the community.
- Learning the basics of the charity finance programmes.
